During your studies do not forget that ACCA qualification consists of 3 parts - exam, ethics, experience. Please use Competency framework to see what practical <u>experience</u> links to your exam. Record and update details of your mentor and your employer details REGULARLY. Students, who do not work for Approved Employers need to answer Challenge questions to 13 Performance objectives and these answers need to be approved by Workplace <u>mentor</u>. Full details on PER requirements available through this <u>video</u>

Students working for Approved Employer can use Approved Employer special forms to record PER.

EXAMS FINISHED



If you are a students with all necessary 14 exams passed, you have one part of the membership completed, but there are few more steps to do. You need to fill in Ethics module and update records of PER. Ethics module is available through MyACCA. PER should be recorded regularly via MyACCA - MyExperience *(if you work for an ACCA approved employer, trainee development, you may use an exemption form to record your PER)*.
