



Directions

Cranfield campus is situated in the Bedfordshire countryside within easy reach of Bedford and Milton Keynes.

By road

From the North and West you should join the M1. Leave the M1 at Junction 14. At the roundabout take the left-hand exit marked 'Cranfield, Newport Pagnell'. About 50 metres from the roundabout turn right at the junction marked 'Moulsoe, Cranfield'. Follow the road through Moulsoe and continue straight on for a further 3.5 km. Take the first turning on the left, marked 'Cranfield University', and simply follow the road which leads into the campus.

From the South, exit the M1 at Junction 13 and follow the road signs.

From the East you should join the A1. From the A1, travel towards Bedford. From Bedford, take the A421, following signs for the M1, then turn right at the 'Little Chef' restaurant onto the minor road sign-posted 'Cranfield'. Follow signs for Cranfield; once in Cranfield village, follow signs to Cranfield University.

By rail

To Milton Keynes: Central Milton Keynes is on the West Coast main line which connects London Euston to the

Midlands, North and North West, and is 8 miles/12 km from Cranfield.

To Bedford: Bedford is on the line connecting London Kings Cross with the North, and is 12 miles/19 km from Cranfield.
