Is accelerate for you?

Final year degree students from any university/college may register. Students must have more than six months prior to completion of their degree programme in order to register for the accelerate

scheme. Students who drop out or who have completed their degree programme are not eligible to register for the accelerate scheme. Nonetheless, these students are eligible to register for ACCA Qualification with full initial registration fee.

How much is the registration fee for accelerate?

All accelerate students are required to pay a **one-time** registration fee of RM100 throughout their entire degree programme. Upon completion of their degree programme, students are able to register with ACCA for FREE (waiver of initial registration fee, £62 for 2007).

What do I do upon completion of my degree?

Accelerate students who have successfully completed their degree programme will be allowed to sit for examinations at the next available examination session. However,

students have the flexibility to decide on which exam sessions they would like to sit for. Please note that accelerate students have up to one year to transfer to ACCA Qualification free of charge. After this period, students will then be required to pay the full initial registration fee.

Students are also required to complete the initial registration (IR) Form, or alternatively register online via myACCA in order to transfer from accelerate student status to ACCA student status.

Accelerate students will need to submit the supporting documents to ACCA Malaysia office upon completion of their degree programme. The documents are as follow:

- A passport photo
- A photocopy of your I/C (on A4 paper)
- Photocopy of your full transcripts/ result slips from year 1 to final year
- Photocopy of degree certificate or letter of completion from the university/college

The following events are conclusive proof of misconduct: conviction for a criminal offence by a UK court, or by a superior court of another country, which discredits you or is derogatory to ACCA or the accountancy profession; a civil judgement by a UK court, or by a superior court of another country, that you have acted fraudulently or dishonestly.
