The closing dates for exam entries are:

15 April for the June session

15 October for the December session

By entering for the examination(s) you are agreeing to be bound by the examination regulations and these terms and conditions. They are also reproduced on your Examination Attendance Docket. You should familiarise yourself with the regulations prior to the examination session.
