

ACCA Faculty Excel moot from 24th

LAHORE: With a view to investing heavily on capacity building in accountancy services across the country, the Association of Certified Chartered Accountants (ACCA) is holding 'ACCA Faculty Excel 2007' in Lahore, Islamabad and Karachi on April 24-27, 2007.

As many as 180 participants are expected to benefit from this conference for which the Association has invited a senior trainer, Rhys Johnson, who is a chartered accountant and FCCA.

Johnson has over 15 years experience of working in the field of accountancy education. As a 'Head of Education at ACCA, he was responsible for the development of the Certified Accounting Technician (CAT) qualification and undertaking a review of the ACCA professional qualification. Until recently he was managing director of the largest private sector accountancy training college in Singapore.
