Student removed from register

On 13 December 2004, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Lilian Acayo of Kampala, Uganda. The complaint that she was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Examination Regulation 3, she took to her desk, used and possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Miss Acayo should be removed from the student register and pay costs of £100, and that the decision should be published in the professional and local press referring to her by name.
