Student severely reprimanded

On 21 January 2004, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Svetlana Gordeeva of Kosmodamianskaya Nab 52/2, Moscow, Russia. The complaint that she was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Examination Regulation 3, she took to her examination desk and possessed while at that desk materials not authorised by the Registrar was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Miss Gordeeva should be severely reprimanded, pay costs of £450, and that the decision should be published in the professional and local press referring to her by name.
