Student removed from register

On 21 January 2004, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Irina Nikuradze, of Vazha Avenue, Tbilisi, Georgia. The complaint that the student was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Examination Regulation 3, she took to her examination desk, used and possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Miss Nikuradze should be removed from the register, pay £450 towards costs, and that the decision should be published in the professional and local press referring to her by name.
