Member severely reprimanded

On 21 April 2004, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a member, Norman Arthur Wainwright, FCCA, sole practitioner trading as Wainwrights, Dibbinview Grove, Wirral, Merseyside. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under by-law 8(a)(i) and (ii) in that, contrary to Fundamental Principle 3 (Independence), he failed to ensure his independence as auditor was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Wainwright should be severely reprimanded, pay a fine of £2,500 and costs of £1,405, and that the decision should be published in the professional and local press referring to him by name.
