## **Member reprimanded**

On 4 August 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against a member, Richard John Fleming, FCCA, formerly sole proprietor of Corporate Accounting Limited of Clear Water Drive, West Didsbury, Manchester. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) and (iii) in that he:

- i) had carried on public practice without holding a practising certificate, contrary to Practising Regulation 3(1)(a) of The Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003

and

- ii) was the sole proprietor and director of a firm where public practice is carried on without holding a practising certificate, contrary to Practising Regulation 3(2) of the UK Annex to The Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Fleming should be reprimanded and pay a fine of £1,500 and costs of £1,965 and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
