Member excluded from membership

On 4 August 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a member, Patrick Charles Morris, formerly of Church Square, Shepperton, Middlesex. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, on 30 January 2004, before a Crown Court, he was convicted of three counts of false accounting, contrary to section 17(1) of the Theft Act 1968 was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Morris should be excluded from membership and pay costs of £750, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
