Member reprimanded

On 8 November 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a member, Howard Terence Stanton, FCCA, sole practitioner, of Queen Anne Street, London, W1G 8HF. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) and/or (iii) in that, contrary to Regulation 16(7)(a) of The Chartered Certified Accountants' Practising Regulations 1998 and Regulation 10(2)(a) of The Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003, he failed to maintain a record of his attendance at acceptable structured courses for the years ending 2001, 2002 and 2003 was found proved under bye-law 8(a)(iii).

The Committee ordered that Mr Stanton should be reprimanded, pay costs of £762.50, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
