Student removed from register

On 8 November 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Zhou Shao You of Bei Wei Road, Nanjing, Jiangsu Province 210029, China. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Examination Regulations, he took to his examination desk and used while at that desk materials not authorised by the Registrar was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Zhou should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £750, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
