## **Member reprimanded**

On 12 April 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a member, David John Ayres , FCCA, of Petersfield Road, Ropley, Alresford, Hampshire. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) and (ii) in that he issued a credit note to a limited company in the name of a firm without the firm's knowledge or authorisation, contrary to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity), was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Ayres should be reprimanded, pay costs of £1,475, and that the decision be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
