Affiliate reprimanded

On 14 June 2005, the Disciplinary Committee considered two complaints against a member, Godfred Ashiagbor of Snowberry Close, Milton Keynes. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law -8(a)(i) and/or (iii) in that he:

- i) held himself out as being in public practice contrary to Membership Regulation 8(b) of The Chartered Certified Accountants' Membership Regulations 1996 (as amended 1 January 2003)

and

- ii) held himself out as a director of a firm which carries on public practice contrary to Membership Regulation 8(b) of The Chartered Certified Accountants' Membership Regulations 1996 (as amended 1 January 2003)

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Ashiagbor should be reprimanded, pay costs of £1,041, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.



Note: ACCA has replaced the term **graduate** with the term **affiliate**. An ACCA affiliate refers to an individual who has completed the ACCA examinations but has not yet applied for full membership.
