Member excluded from membership

On 20 April 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against a member, Roy Andrew Anstead, of Queen's Club Gardens, London W14 9SL. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that he failed to:

- i) behave with integrity in all professional, business and personal financial relationships, contrary to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity)

and

- ii) co-operate with ACCA, contrary to Regulation 3(3) of The Chartered Certified Accountants' Disciplinary Regulations 2001

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Anstead should be excluded from membership and pay a fine of £5,000 and costs of £1,195, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
