## **Student removed from register**

On 20 April 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Ms Dong Youqing, of Toa Payoh Lorong 1, Singapore. The complaint that she was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Examination Regulation 3, she took to her examination desk, used and possessed while at that desk material not authorised by the Registrar and, contrary to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity), intended to use it was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Miss Youqing should be removed from the register and pay costs of £300, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to her by name.
