Student removed from register

On 21 February 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Haroon Ali of Machine Moh Allah, Jhelum, Pakistan. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity), he provided ACCA with Computer Based Examination certificates which falsely attested to having been awarded passes in papers B1, B2 and B3 of the technician syllabus was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Ali should be removed from the student register, pay £200 towards costs, and that the decision should be published in the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
