## **Member excluded from membership**

On 21 February 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against a member, Marcel Pierre Renault of Mossop Drive, Langtoft, Peterborough. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(iii) in that he:

- i) had carried on public practice without a practising certificate, contrary to Practising Regulation 3(1) of the UK Annex to The Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003

and

- ii) was the sole proprietor of a firm where public practice is carried on, contrary to Practising Regulation 3(2) of the UK Annex to The Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Renault should be excluded from membership, pay a fine of £5,000 and costs of £1,195, and that the decision should be published in the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
