## **Student removed from register**

On 21 February 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Oleg Terentyev, of Proletarskya St, Volgograd, Russia. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Examination Regulation 3, he took to his examination desk and used and possessed while at that desk materials not authorised by the Registrar was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Terentyev should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £750, and that the decision should be published in the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
