## **Member reprimanded**

On 22 March 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against a member, Barrie Neil Sinclair, ACCA, of Lochore, Lochgelly, Fife. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(iii) in that he:

- i) removed files from his employers without their knowledge or consent, contrary to Rule 3.2.4.19 (Use of confidential information for personal advantage) and to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity)

and

- ii) improperly retained monies due to his employer, contrary to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity)

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Sinclair should be reprimanded, pay costs of £960, and that the decision should be published in the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
