Student removed from register

On 22 March 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Giorgi Tsaia of Tsereteli, Tbilisi, Georgia. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) and (iii) in that, contrary to Examination Regulation 3, he took to his desk and possessed while at that desk materials not authorised by the Registrar and, contrary to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity) intended to use it was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Tsaia should be removed from the student register, pay £75 towards costs, and that the decision should be published in the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
