## **Student removed from register**

On 22 November 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Ilyas Khan, of Green Town, Karachi, Sindh 43, Pakistan. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Examination Regulations, he took to his desk and possessed while at that desk materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use the unauthorised material, contrary to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity) was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Khan should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £680, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
