Student removed from register

On 22 November 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Asim Zeeshan, of Sindhi Mollah Street, Okara, Punjab, Pakistan. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity), he submitted false documentation to ACCA was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Zeeshan should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £750, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
