Affiliate reprimanded

On 24 May 2005, the Disciplinary Committee considered three complaints against an affiliate, Habib Lawal of John Ruskin Street, London SE5 0XQ. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) and/or (iii) in that he:

- i) claimed to be a member of the Association contrary to Regulation 6(1)(a) of The Chartered Certified Accountants' Membership Regulations 1996 (as amended 1 January 2003)

and/or

- ii) held himself out to be in public practice contrary to Regulation 8(b) of The Chartered Certified Accountants' Membership Regulations 1996 (as amended 1 January 2003)

and/or

- iii) held himself out to be a partner of a firm which carries on public practice contrary to Regulation 8(b) of the Chartered Certified Accountants' Membership Regulations 1996 (as amended 1 January 2003)

were found proved.
