Student removed from register

On 25 August 2005, the Disciplinary Committee considered a complaint against a student, Zhang Yan of People's Mansion, Singapore. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Examination Regulation 3, he took to his desk and possessed while at that desk materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use the unauthorised material, contrary to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity) was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Yan should be removed from the student register and pay costs of £820, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
