## **Member excluded from membership**

On 25 October 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered three complaints against a member, Mustafa Daoud Abulhawa of Roefields Close, Felden, Hemel Hempstead, Herts. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) and (iii) in that he:

- i) failed to behave with integrity, contrary to Fundamental Principle 2  
  
and
- ii) carried on public practice without holding a practising certificate, contrary to Practising Regulation 3(1)(a) of the Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003  
  
and
- iii) is a sole proprietor of a firm where public practice is carried on without a practising certificate, contrary to Practising Regulation 3(2) of the Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003

were found proved.



The Committee ordered that Mr Abulhawa should be excluded from membership, pay costs of £1,282, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
