Student removed from register

On 26 July 2005, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Sarah Mwayerah of Budiro, Harare, Zimbabwe. The complaint that she was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Examination Regulation 3, she took to her desk and possessed while at that desk materials not authorised by the Registrar and, contrary to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity), intended to use the unauthorised material, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Miss Mwayerah should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £820, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to her by name.
