Member reprimanded

On 5 April 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against a member, Henry David Henricksen, FCCA, of Shannon Way, Evesham, Worcestershire. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(iii) in that:

- i) he had carried on public practice without holding a practising certificate, contrary to Regulation 3(1)(a) of The Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003

and
- ii) was the director of a firm where public practice is carried on without holding a practising certificate, contrary to Regulation 3(2) of the UK Annex to The Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Henricksen should be reprimanded, pay a fine of £1,000 and costs of £1,268, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
