Student severely reprimanded

On 5 September 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student Michelle Peters of Burdett Avenue, London. The complaint that she was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that she took to her desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use it, contrary to Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Miss Peters should be severely reprimanded, pay costs of £610, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to her by name.
