Student severely reprimanded

On Tuesday 7 November 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Mr Syed Ali Raza Bukhari of Ferozpur Road, Ichhra, Punjab. The complaint was that Mr Bukhari was liable to disciplinary action in that he provided ACCA, or knowingly allowed ACCA to be provided, with false statements of examination results, purportedly issued by CIMA and ICSM, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Bukhari should be severely reprimanded, pay costs of £100, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
