## **Student reprimanded**

On 7 November 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Mr Muhammad Bilah Hussain Khan of Rippling Road, Barking. The complaint was that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, he provided ACCA, or knowingly allowed ACCA to be provided, with false statements of examination results, purportedly issued by CIMA, ICSM and IMIS, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Khan should be reprimanded, pay costs of £100, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
