Student severely reprimanded

On 7 December 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Ms Saima Saba of Sumbriyal Road, Daska, Pakistan. The complaint was that Ms Saba was liable to disciplinary action in that, she failed to inform ACCA of material facts relevant to the exemptions from ACCA papers granted to her, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Ms Saba should be severely reprimanded, pay costs of £100, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to her by name.
