Student removed from register

On 8 August 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Lin Wang of Leicester, Leicestershire. The complaint that the student was liable to disciplinary action in that, contrary to Examination Regulations, she took to her desk and possessed while at that desk unauthorised materials, which were prepared with the intention of using them to cheat in the exam, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Miss Wang should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £250 and that the decision be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to her by name.
