Student removed from register

On 8 November 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against a student, Mr Arif Ahmed Khan formerly known as Mr Ayube Ahmad Bakhsh of High Road, Wood Green. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action:

- i) Under bye-law 8 (a)(i), in that, in March 2004, he stole cheques belonging to clients of his then employers, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity

and

- ii) Under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that, between April and May 2004, he submitted false information in his application for a job at a firm, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Khan should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £985, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
