Student removed from register

On 8 November 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Mr Meng Zhen of Sherwood Court, Hong Kong. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to the Examination Regulations, he took to his desk and possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use the unauthorised materials to gain an unfair advantage in the examination, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Zhen should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £610, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
