Student removed from register

On 13 December 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Mr Naveed Piyar Ali of Karimabad Colony, Karachi, Pakistan. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, he provided ACCA, or knowingly allowed ACCA to be provided with false statements of examination results, purportedly issued by CIMA, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Ali should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £100, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
