Member excluded from membership

On 19 September 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against a member, Ng Wai Sang of Hennessey Road, Hong Kong. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action in that:

- i) Under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that on 29 January 2003, in the District Court of Hong Kong, he was convicted of conspiracy to defraud

and
- ii) (a) Under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that he carried on public practice without holding a practising certificate from 1 July 2004 to 1 February 2005, contrary to Global Practising Regulation 3(1) [2004] and 3(2) [2005] of the Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003

and
- (b) Under bye-law 8a(iii), in he carried on public practice without holding a practising certificate from 1 July 2004 to 1 February 2005, contrary to regulations 3(1) [2004] and 3(2) [2005] of



the Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising
Regulations 2003

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Ng should be excluded from membership, pay costs of £1,044, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
