Student removed from register

On 21 March 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Akif Ali Naz, of Yaseen Abad, Faisalabad, Pakistan. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that he used obscene language in his examination script during the course of an examination was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Naz should be removed from the student register and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
