Student removed from register

On 21 March 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Noman Riaz, of Nazimabad, Karachi, Pakistan. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Examination Regulations, he took to his desk and possessed while at that desk unauthorised handwritten notes, which were prepared with the intention of using them to cheat in the exam contrary to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity), was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Riaz should be removed from the student register, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
