Student removed from register

On 24 October 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against a student, Mr Faisal Rashid M Al Hajsri of Doha, Qatar. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action in that:

- i) under bye-law 8(a)(i), contrary to Examination Regulations, he took to his desk and possessed while at that desk unauthorised materials, which were prepared with the intention of using them to cheat in the exam, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity

and

- ii) under bye-law 8(a)(iii), he refused to handover unauthorised materials discovered in his possession, contrary to Examination Regulations, which require students to comply in all respects with any instructions issued by the Registrar, Exam Supervisors and Invigilators before and during the exam

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Al Hajri should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £610 and that the decision should be published by
