Member severely reprimanded

On 27 July 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a member, Jason Stephen Butler, ACCA, of Rush Croft, Bradford, West Yorkshire. The complaint that the member was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that he was guilty of misconduct having signed an Accountants Certificate without holding a practising certificate, contrary to regulation 3(1) of The Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Butler should be severely reprimanded, pay a fine of £5,000 and costs of £890, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
