Student severely reprimanded

On 27 July 2006, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Alicja Marasinska, of Breamore Close, London SW15 4NW. The complaint that the student was liable to disciplinary action in that, contrary to Examination Regulations, she took to her desk and possessed while at that desk unauthorised handwritten notes, which were prepared with the intention of using them to cheat in the exam contrary to Fundamental Principle 2 (Integrity), was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Miss Marasinska should be severely reprimanded, pay costs of £610, and that the decision should be published in the professional, national and local press referring to her by name. The Committee further ordered that Miss Marasinska should be disqualified from the examination which was the subject of the allegation.
