## **Student removed from register**

On 1 February 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Ms Kong Siew Theeng of Jurong West Ave 1, Singapore. The complaint that she was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law8(a)(i), in that contrary to the Examination Regulations, she took to her desk and possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use the unauthorised materials to gain an unfair advantage in the examination, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Ms Theeng should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £762.50, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to her by name.
