## **Student removed from register**

On 5 July 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a Mr Abdul Razzaq of Lahore, Punjab, Pakistan. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, he relied upon a false examination certificate by representing that he had passed the examination when he knew that he had not, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Razzaq should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £610, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
