## **Student removed from register**

On 12 June 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Mr Ali Raza of Multan, Punjab, Pakistan. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that he provided ACCA with a falsified certificate, attesting that he had gained a Degree in Computing from an overseas university, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Raza should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £680, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
