Student removed from register

On 13 March 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against a student, Ms Mehreen Javed of Movers Lane, Barking. The complaints that she was liable to disciplinary action:

- i) under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that she failed to inform ACCA of material facts relevant to the exemptions from ACCA papers granted to her, namely that she had not, at the time she became aware that the exemptions had been granted, sat examinations in any of the qualifications which were the basis for the exemptions she had been awarded, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity

and

- (ii) under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that she knowingly made false statements to ACCA, namely that she told ACCA that she had sat examinations for the classes she had taken at a tuition provider, knowing that those statements were not true, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity

were found proved.



The Committee ordered that Ms Javed should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £100, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to her by name.
