Student removed from register

On 13 March 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Mr Muhammad Shahbaz of Town Ship, Lahore, Pakistan. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that he sought to induce ACCA to rely on fraudulent statements of examination results, knowing those statements to be false, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Shahbaz should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £100, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
