Student removed from register

On 13 December 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Mr Rupert Coles of West Ilsley, Newbury. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, on 28 April 2006 in the Crown Court at Oxford he was convicted of two counts of theft and two of false accounting, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Coles should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £762.50, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
