Student removed from register

On 13 December 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Ms Phang Wei Wei of Block 303 Ang Mo Kio, Singapore. The complaint that she was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, contrary to Examination Regulations, she took to her desk and possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use the unauthorised materials to gain unfair advantage in the examination contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Ms Phang should be removed from the student/affiliate register, pay costs of £250, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to her by name.
